He is Professor in Obstetrics - Gynecology - Maternal Fetal Medicine and the Chairman of the 3rd Department Ob Gyn of the Medical School of Aristotle University, Thessaloniki, Greece. He was specialized at the Maternal Fetal Medicine Unit of the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology at Yale University, USA.

His scientific contribution accounts for more than 200 scientific papers, presentations, articles and chapters. His papers have been cited more than 1800 times in the Science Citation Index. He has been invited as lecturer and has given more than 350 lectures in international and Greek congresses and meetings.

He envisioned and realized, with the collaboration of other professors and specialists in the field, the creation of the "South East European Society of Perinatal Medicine", in which 13 countries participate.

Recently, he was elected as the Director of the Surgical Section of the Medical School of Aristotle University of Thessaloniki. At present he serves as: President of the "Obstetrics and Gynecology Society of Thessaloniki" and member of the Executive Board of the "*European Association of Perinatal Medicine*" and "*Hellenic Society of Obstetrics and Gynecology*".

He is an Associate Member of the "International Academy of Perinatal Medicine", Visiting Professor at the Weill Cornell Medical College USA, the European University Cyprus and the Zucker School of Medicine at Hofstra/ Northwell NY, USA.
